



A Snapshot of How We Closed Out 2012

Between October 1 and December 31, 2012, ECAC:

- Resettled 70 refugees from Iraq, Bhutan, Burma, Afghanistan, Iran, Ethiopia and Eritrea
- Served 104 clients in employment services and placed 40 clients in jobs
- Had 25 children continue to attend its Afterschool Program
- Recruited 47 volunteers who provided 1075.79 hours of service in various programs
- Taught 88 students English as a Second Language (ESL) classes 4 days a week in three levels (Level 1, 2 and 3).
- Graduated 24 students from its Electromechanical Assembly Training (EMAT) program on December 20, 2012
- Provided Basic and Intermediate computer training for 27 clients
- Provided free general computer/internet access for 54 clients
